

Club Trophies

Gordon Mealing trophy	Presented by the committee to the person deemed to have contributed most to the functioning of the club.
Keevil cup	Highest National ladder points. Open to all gliders and pilots.
Park cup	Highest National ladder points in a non-powered glider, or with the engine not operable.
Distance trophy - presented by Dick and Mary Dixon starting 2009	For the longest handicapped flight originating from The Park using up to four TPs. Does not have to be pre declared.
Club glider trophy	Highest National ladder points in a privately owned or club glider, up to the handicap of the club Astir JKW.
Junior ladder	For pilots under age 25. Awarded to the pilot with the greatest achievement.
100 K	For the fastest handicapped speed around a 100K triangle. (Between 100K and 200K).
Four Cathedrals	For the fastest handicapped speed around Salisbury Cathedral, Sherborne Abbey, Wells Cathedral & Bath Abbey. Can be flown in any order.
Height award	For the greatest height gain.
Almost did it	For the best try.

All the cross-country trophies are scored under National Ladder rules.

Only flights between 1st October and 31st September from The Park, Interclub League or organised club expeditions in the UK are eligible for scoring.
