1. New members

- If joining during the membership year, which runs from 1st March, you pay a reduced subscription for flying memberships in proportion to the number of months remaining in the membership year – if for instance you join in June there are 9 months of the annual sub to pay. See chart in clubhouse and caravan.
- Associate membership is not a pro rata.
- Existing members cannot claim a proportional reduction when renewing membership.

2. Family membership

- Is 1.5 times the normal adult subscription.
- It allows two adult members of a family to have one adult membership at the full adult rate and one membership at half the adult rate.

3. Junior members

- Are under age 25

4. Cadet members

- Are age 14 - 18

5. Associate membership

- Allows the associate member to fly occasionally in the motorglider, a syndicate aircraft or a spare two-seater, but not to receive instructional flights.

6. Glider trailer fee

- Permits a flying member to keep a glider trailer in the trailer park and to have use of the club facilities for one glider only.
- Self-launchers are charged at twice the trailer fee.

7. Trial Flights

- Are one flight of up to 30 minutes, or 60 minutes for the Mile-High tow.
- Further flights can be had at normal club rates on that day.
- Trial Flights include 90 days club membership, valid from the date of the Trial Flight.
- 1 Mile tow is 4600ft above the airfield.
- Winch launched Trial Flights are £65 but are not available by voucher.

8. Winch launches

- Launches before 10:00 are half price.

9. Soaring

- The maximum soaring charge is 3 hours per flight.
- No soaring charge for a successful Silver Badge 5-hour flight.

10. Aerotow retrieves

- Gliders retrieved or towed out are charged per kilometre away from The Park.
- Minimum price is £50.
- There is a separate notice of calculated prices to local gliding clubs.
- Retrieves are charged per km to or from another airfield. See the Retrieve Sheet.

11. Eurofox flights

- For Tug pilots only and is charged by flight time, not EMSIS.
- £91.20 per hour (1.52ppm) for all training flights.
- Currency and recency flights are £91.20 per hour (1.52ppm) for the first 20 minutes of each session. Further time over 20 minutes is £135 per hour (2.25ppm).

12. Reciprocal membership

- No charge to other BGA club members for the first 5 days.
- After 5 days a daily flying membership¹³ is payable

13. The Daily Flying membership charge applies to the following:

- Reciprocal members, but see note 12. Flying charges are at the rate appropriate to the age of the pilot.
- Flying in a club glider, the motorglider, or any syndicate aircraft.
- Friends and Family of members. Flying charges are at the rate appropriate to the age of the pilot.

14. Groups of 10 or more

- Subsequent flights on the same day are charged at normal club rates appropriate to the age of the pilot.
- 90-day membership is not included.

15. Heron Navy

- 1st flight is by aerotow to 3000 feet at £57.
- Subsequent flights are at club rates, appropriate to the age of the pilot.
