Trophy	Description	Winner 2024
Gordon Mealing trophy	Presented by the committee to the person deemed to have contributed most to the functioning of the club	Graham Hoile
Keevil cup	Highest National Ladder points. Open to all gliders and pilots	Alastair MacGregor
Park cup	Highest National Ladder points in a non-powered glider, or with the engine not operable	Tim Brunskill
Distance trophy	For the longest handicapped flight from The Park	Alastair MacGregor
Club two-seater trophy	For the highest scoring cross country flight in a club two-seater. Awarded to both pilots	No claims
Club glider trophy	Highest National Ladder points in a privately owned or club glider, up to the handicap of the club Astir JKW	Tim Brunskill
Junior trophy	The pilot who has achieved the most in the year, and is under age 25	James Farr
Dick Hadlow trophy	Presented by the CFI for airmanship. To the most deserving Junior member	James Farr
100K trophy	Fastest handicapped speed around declared or club triangle scored as 100-200 km with any deductions for height loss or turnpoint type taken into account. The triangle must qualify as a FAI 28% triangle but may use additional turnpoints according to BGA Ladder rules (i.e. currently qualifying for a shape factor of 1.08). The task must be completed. Height award	Greatest height gain	No claims
Almost did it trophy	For the best try	Tim Brunskill
